
Description

- "Magree and Asteris" was created during the implementation of the eTwinning Project "Here comes the Sun" by 2nd grade partner classes from Greece and Malta.
- The name Magree is a combination of two partner classes countries, Malta and Greece. The name "Asteris" in Greek means "Star".
- It was inspired by two books "The Ray-Weaver" by Vassiliki Nevrokopli and "Sun bread" by Elisa Kleven. Pupils formed interschool working groups of authors and illustrators. They mixed characters from the two books and came up with new characters to create their own collaborative story.


